



GOODSTREAK

Goodstreak is medium in maturity. It has a long coleoptile. The mature plant height of Goodstreak is 38 inches. It has moderate straw strength. The winter hardiness of Goodstreak is good to very good. Goodstreak is moderately resistant to stem and stripe rust and Hessian fly. It is susceptible to leaf rust and wheat streak mosaic virus. Goodstreak was evaluated as NE97465 in Nebraska yield nurseries. It was selected from the cross SD3055/KS88H164//NE89646. Goodstreak was developed cooperatively by the Nebraska Agricultural Experiment Station and the USDA-ARS and released by the developing institutions and the Wyoming Agricultural Experiment Station. Non-complementary varieties include Pronghorn. U.S. Protected Variety (PVPA 1994). Certificate No. 200300281. Goodstreak can only be sold as a class of certified seed.
