The purpose of this directory is to provide crop producers, decision makers and the seed industry with a reference to seed sources in Nebraska.

This seed book includes those members whose fields were planted with eligible seed stocks and whose applications for field inspection were received by the publication date.

Inquiries about seed supplies and prices should be directed to the growers and/or seed enterprises listed, not to the Nebraska Crop Improvement Association.

In no case is the seed listed in this seed book yet **CERTIFIED**, for it must be conditioned, tested in the laboratory, and labeled with the official certification tag or bulk sale certificate before it can be offered for sale as Certified Quality Seed.

Seed producers, conditioners, and distributors voluntarily use the seed certification process to assure their customers that extra care has been taken to provide them with correctly identified, genetically pure seed. The **CERTIFIED SEED** label identifies seed meeting quality requirements and assures the buyer of obtaining reliable performance of the variety named on the label.

Each member is responsible for handling certifiable seed so it will also meet the Nebraska Certification Standards for physical purity and germination. The Nebraska Seed Law requires **EACH** container of seed be labeled as to its origin, the germination percentage and date of test, the percentage by weight of pure seed, other crop seed, weed seed, and inert matter. By studying the **CERTIFIED LABEL**, a buyer can determine the quality of the seed. If Certified seed is purchased in the bulk, each sale is accompanied by an official Retail Bulk Sale Certificate, which includes the same information as a label.

Orders for Certified seed may be accepted by the listed growers, approved conditioners, and authorized distributors only with the understanding that they will be filled if and when **ALL** the certification requirements are completed.



**PLANT VARIETY PROTECTION ACT

- Any varieties listed in this publication under the Plant Variety Protection Act will be marked with the **PVP** logo.
- It takes up to ten years to develop a new variety. PVP encourages plant breeding research to produce even better varieties for tomorrow. Without PVP, plant breeders could not afford to invest capital into new varieties and would not be interested in breeding improved varieties.
- Most protected varieties can only be sold as certified quality seed. This helps ensure that the seed buyer gets the variety exactly as the breeder intended it to be.

WHEAT VARIETY SELECTION & COMPLEMENTATION

Because there is no single perfect variety, using complementation enables you to offset the potential weaknesses (production limitations) found in each variety with the strengths of others. This compensation improves the opportunity for yield stability and profitability of your entire wheat production system.

The number of complementary varieties you grow or the acres to be planted to each variety will depend entirely on your production conditions and special needs. There are four simple steps in using the variety complementation strategy.

1. **Identify your workhorse varieties**-These are the varieties now being grown on a majority of your acres with a reliable and proven record of performance over a period of years.
2. **Complement production needs and limits** - Select varieties that have useful characteristics needed for your specific production practices, soil conditions, and offer the best protection from diseases and other yield limiting factors common to your growing area.
3. **Complement with a range of maturities** - Select varieties that mature earlier or later than your workhorse variety, because some years may favor early varieties and some may favor later varieties. A spread of maturities will also allow you to stagger your harvest and take maximum advantage of your equipment and reduce potential losses to weathering, etc.
4. **Complement with different genetics** - Select varieties that share 50% or less similar parentage to your workhorse variety and each other. Varieties with similar genetic backgrounds can often be susceptible to the same disease and production risks.

HARD RED WINTER WHEAT

PVP SY 517 CL2 - SY 517 CL2 is a two gene Clearfield wheat. As a two gene variety, SY 517 CL2 has a strong herbicide tolerance for the Beyond herbicide and MSO to control unwanted cheat, goatgrass, feral rye, and other weeds. It is medium maturity variety with excellent test weight, good straw strength and good winter hardiness. SY 517 CL2 is moderately tolerant to fusarium head blight, stem and leaf rust and resistant to Soil-Born Mosaic virus. U.S. Protected Variety (PVPA 1994). Certificate No. 201700216. SY 517 CL2 can only be sold as a class of certified seed.

PVP AP18 AX - AP18 AX is a medium maturity Aggressor herbicide tolerant line with excellent yield potential. It has strong disease tolerance to wheat streak mosaic virus, leaf rust, and stripe rust. These traits, in addition to its winter hardiness, shatter resistance, and very good test weight, makes AP18 AX a great fit across the plains. U.S. Plant Variety Protection Applied For (PVPA 1994). PVP AgriPro brand AP503 CL2 - AP503 CL2 is an awned, white chaffed, medium maturing, semidwarf with excellent straw strength. It has good winterhardness and very good milling and baking qualities. It has moderate resistance to leaf and stripe rusts and is susceptible to Hessian fly. It contains two genes that confers tolerance to the BASF herbicide Beyond and is to be used as a component of the BASF CLEARFIELD Production System which requires the grower must purchase Certified AP503 CL2 wheat seed and must agree not to save seed for planting. Any unauthorized planting variety will be punishable under the U.S. Patent law. It was developed, produced, and marketed exclusively under the AgriPro brand name. U.S. Protected Variety (PVPA 1994). LCS Atomic AX is known for how well it handles heat and drought conditions. This variety has quick emergence and has a strong disease package. LCS Atomic AX is resistant to Aggressor® brand herbicides, making it an excellent tool to clean up fields with Bromus species, feral rye, cereal rye, jointed goatgrass, wild oats and volunteer cereals. PVP AVERY - Avery is an awned, white-chaffed, medium maturing wheat with medium height, a medium-long coleoptile, fair straw strength, and average test weight. Avery is derived from the cross TAM 112/Byrd. It has good winterhardness, excellent drought tolerance, and very high yield potential. Avery has slightly larger kernels, two days later heading date, and slightly improved baking quality characteristics compared to Byrd. It is moderately susceptible to susceptible to prevalent races of stripe rust (2012 races), susceptible to leaf rust and stem rust, moderately susceptible to wheat streak mosaic virus, susceptible to all biotypes of the Russian wheat aphid, and resistant to Greenbug biotype E, the wheat curl mite, and wheat soil borne mosaic virus. Bob Dole has excellent low pH tolerance. It has a lower tillering capacity, so planting populations should be increased. This wheat has excellent end use characteristics. Stripe and stem rust resistance is excellent with good resistance to WSMV & SBMV. Canvas maintains excellent test weight and makes protein very well. End-use quality is very good. PVP COWBOY - Cowboy is an awned, white-glumed, hard red winter wheat that has been jointly released by the Colorado Agricultural Experiment Station, the University of Wyoming Agricultural Experiment Station and the CRFW. Cowboy is medium in height and coleoptile length with fair straw strength and has adequate winter hardiness for the central and southern Great Plains area. Cowboy has resistance to stripe rust and moderate resistant to US races of stem rust. Cowboy is also resistant to Hessian fly. Cowboy is susceptible to leaf rust and (Ug99) stem rust. Epoch is a short stature, semi-dwarf line with excellent straw strength to reduce lodging under irrigation.

PVP FORTIFY SF - Fortify SF is a medium early hard red winter wheat that has a stem-solidness trait that helps defend against the wheat stem Fortify SF expresses more pith development in the stems than traditional hollow-stemmed wheats, while not being completely solid-stemmed. Fortify SF has good drought tolerance and good test weight. It is resistant to Wheat Streak Mosaic Virus and susceptible to strip and leaf rust. U.S. Plant Variety Protection Applied For (PVPA 1994). PVP Husker Genetics FREEMAN brand (NE06545) - Freeman is a semi-dwarf wheat moderately early in maturity and approximate mature plant height of 34 inches. It has moderate straw strength and good winter hardiness. It is resistant to Soilborne wheat mosaic virus and moderately resistant to moderately susceptible to stem rust, leaf rust, and stripe rust. It is moderately susceptible to Fusarium head blight and susceptible to Hessian fly, barley yellow dwarf virus, and wheat streak mosaic virus. Freeman was developed cooperatively by the Nebraska Agricultural Experiment Station and the USDA-ARS. PVP GOODSTREAK - Goodstreak is medium in maturity. It has a long coleoptile. The mature plant height of Goodstreak is 38 inches. It has moderate straw strength. The winter hardiness of Goodstreak is good to very good. Goodstreak is moderately resistant to stem and stripe rust and Hessian fly. It is susceptible to leaf rust and wheat streak mosaic virus. PVP GUARDIAN - Guardian has superior resistance to wheat viruses, from stacking a gene for resistance to the Wheat Streak Mosaic Virus with a gene for resistance to the wheat curl mite which transmits WSMV, wheat mosaic virus, and triticum mosaic virus. PVP INFINITY CL - Infinity CL is a medium maturing, semi-dwarf variety selected from the cross Windstar//Millennium/Above. The mature plant height is shorter than Millennium and taller than Wesley. Infinity CL is an awned, white-glumed cultivar with moderate straw strength, similar to Wahoo, but worse than Wesley. It is moderately resistant to stem rust, leaf rust, and stripe rust. It is susceptible to Hessian fly and Wheat Soilborne Mosaic virus. It is available from NuPride Genetics Network Affiliates. U.S. Protected Variety (PVPA 1994). Certificate No. 200600172. KIVARI AX - Kivari AX has slightly later maturity and improved spring frost tolerance compared to Crescent AX. It offers improved yield performance with excellent drought tolerance proven by its Byrd parent. Kivari AX has good test weight, wheat curl mite resistance, but weaker straw in high moisture environments. It's recommended to be planted on dryland acres of the central high plains only.

PVP LANGIN - Langin is an awned, white-chaffed, early maturing wheat with medium-short height, a medium length coleoptile, fair straw strength, and good test weight. It is derived from the cross CO050270/Byrd (CO050270 = Hatcher/NW97S295 pedigree). Langin has good winterhardiness, excellent drought stress tolerance, and very high yield potential. It has improved stripe rust resistance and slightly improved baking quality characteristics compared to Byrd. Langin is moderately resistant to prevalent races of stripe rust, susceptible to leaf rust and stem rust, moderately susceptible to wheat streak mosaic virus, susceptible to all biotypes of the Russian wheat aphid, and resistant to the wheat curl mite and wheat soil borne mosaic virus. TURFGRASSES

Buffalograss is a long-lived, sod-forming, native warm-season perennial grass which reproduces by seed and spreads vegetatively by stolons. It is very suitable for use under low to medium maintenance as an ecologically sound and energy efficient turf. It may be established by seed, plugs, or sod. Even without mowing, plants are very short height (6-8 inches). Buffalograss begins growth in mid to late May and begins to go dormant with the first frost. PERENNIAL FORAGE GRASSES

Big Bluestem is a native warm-season, sod-forming grass which grows rapidly from mid-spring to early fall. Plants are tall (6+ ft) and robust. It is highly palatable even after maturity and is a high producer of nutritious forage and hay. Big bluestem is adapted statewide for range seedling on subirrigated sites and for irrigated pasture in mixed or pure stands. In eastern Nebraska, it is adapted on silty and clay sites.

PVP BONANZA - Bonanza is a synthetic variety developed by three generations of breeding for improved forage yield and forage digestibility. It produces good forage yields with high digestibility that results in improved animal gains when utilized by beef cattle in well managed grazing systems. 1. To expand the marketing options of seed producers who may not have adequate cleaning or merchandising facilities.
2. To provide the retail seed trade with reliable high quality sources of seed.
3. To improve the quality of seed available, while insuring maintenance of varietal purity.
4. To promote acceptance and use of Nebraska certified seed.

1. To provide necessary conditioning services for seed producers and merchandisers who do not have adequate cleaning facilities.
2. To improve the quality of seed available while insuring maintenance of varietal purity.
3. To promote acceptance and use of Nebraska certified seed.
